

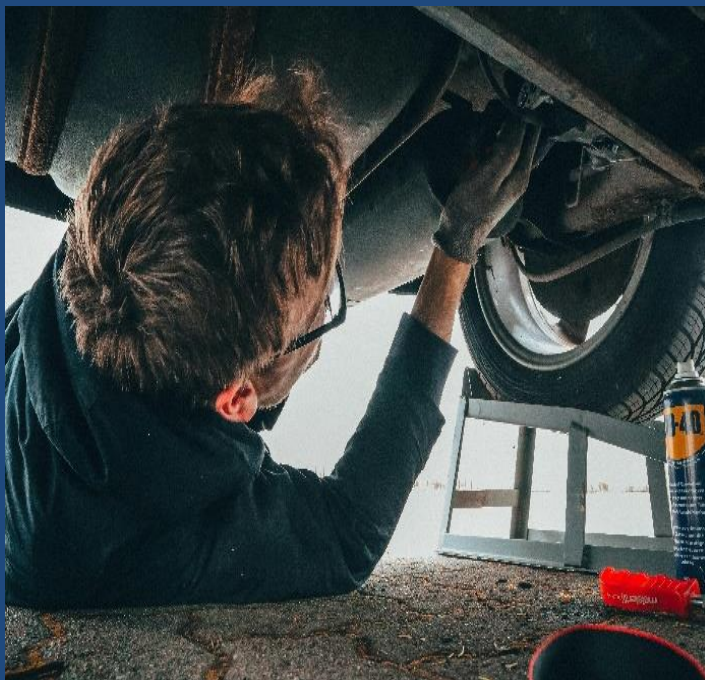

1. **Level 1 Award in Motor Vehicle Studies**

An entry-level qualification introducing basic motor vehicle principles, ideal for beginners or those considering a career in vehicle repair and maintenance.

- Awarding Body: SEG Awards
- Duration: 6–8 weeks part-time
- Guided Learning Hours: 240
- Structure: Basic vehicle systems, workshop safety, introduction to tools and equipment.

2. **Level 2 Award in Motor Vehicle Studies (Light Vehicle)**

Designed for learners with some experience or those progressing from Level 1. Covers diagnostics, repair, and essential workshop skills.

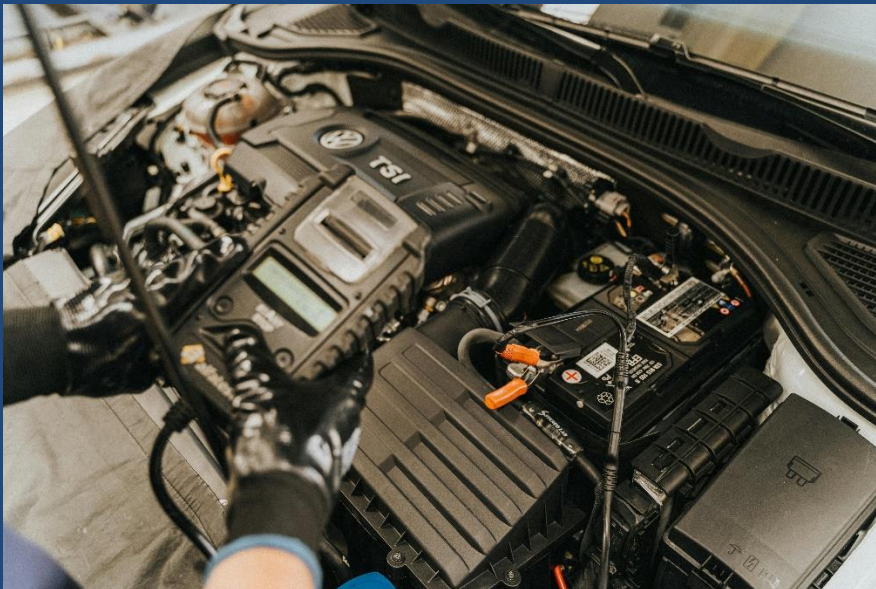
- Awarding Body: SEG Awards
- Duration: 12–16 weeks full-time or part-time
- GLH Estimate: 300–400

- Structure: Engine technology, electrical systems, braking and steering maintenance

3. **Level 3 Award in Motor Vehicle Studies**

Advanced study aimed at individuals pursuing technical or supervisory roles in the motor industry. Includes in-depth diagnostics, systems management, and safety checks.

- Awarding Body: IMI
- Duration: 20–24 weeks part-time or 12 weeks full-time
- Based on standard IMI delivery formats
- Structure: Diagnostics, hybrid systems, transmission, advanced mechanical systems



4. **Level 2 Award in MOT Testing (Classes 4 and 7)**

Prepares individuals to become authorised MOT Testers for cars and light commercial vehicles.

- Awarding Body: SEG Awards
- Duration: 3–5 days full-time or split evening delivery
- GLH: Minimum 29 (including at least 8 hours practical)
- Requirements: Must meet DVSA entry criteria
- Structure: DVSA regulations, vehicle inspection routines, MOT assessment and certification

5. **Level 3 Award in MOT Test Centre Management**

Tailored for existing or aspiring MOT Centre Managers. Covers DVSA compliance, site operations, and staff management.

- Awarding Body: SEG Awards
- Duration: 1–2 days (full-time or split sessions)
- GLH: Approx. 8–10 hours
- Designed for: Current or aspiring MOT Centre Managers
- Structure: Managing MOT operations, compliance, centre documentation, staff responsibility

- Functional English and basic maths
- Prior experience for MOT courses as per DVSA requirements
